ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

This quote is a complete system that allows the Springfield County Health Department to monitor, alarm, and log the temperature inside both compartments (refrigerator and freezer) of two full size refrigerators.

The temperature sensors will go inside the refrigerator and freezer compartments and relate the temperature to the VM500-5-DCP-E.

The door sensors will go on the doors of the refrigerator and freezer compartments and relate their open/closed state to the VM500-5-DCP-E.

The Data Capture software will run on a computer that is on the network and collect the temperature readings and door status from the VM500-5-DCP-E.

These readings are archived on the computer and reports and graphs can be run at any time for any specified date range.

If the temperature of any of the compartments goes out of range for too long or the doors are left open for too long, the VM500-5-DCP-E will call up to four (4) telephone numbers with a detailed alarm message.

The VM500-5-DCP-E will also alarm locally with its alarm buzzer and show the current status on its screen.

The Data Capture software will send alarm email messages out to a list of recipients.
